#### **Target Audience:**

Professionals from around the world who are interested in exploring Germany, learning about European history and EU values, and discussing current political and economic issues.

#### Aims:

The world is currently navigating a landscape marked by a range of political and economic challenges, including the rise of authoritarianism, declining happiness with their socioeconomic situations, the rise of populistic movements, the emergence of potential bipolar global power dynamics, and more.

This program offers an opportunity to delve into these shifting global realities, fostering a deeper understanding of the issues that will shape our collective future. It also highlights how Europe's historical and political framework can offer valuable lessons in addressing today's crises. Participants will have the chance to explore how democratic societies can respond to these challenges and how international cooperation can pave the way for a more hopeful and sustainable future.

Where challenges exist, so too do opportunities. We are presented with a unique chance to learn from the past, contribute to creating a better future, and deepen our understanding of the world around us. This program invites participants to engage with the cultural, historical, and linguistic diversity of different nations, fostering greater empathy and global awareness.

The participants will explore Germany, its rich history, vibrant culture, and language. They will also examine the history and current level of German relations and its contribution to European integration.

The course combines lectures delivered in English, excursions in Germany and France, and interactive workshops and group projects.
